- Beginning, Middle, End
- Setting, Character, Plot, Theme
- Throughline, Point



Say What You're Going To Say

- Introduction, Beginning
- Set Up
- Overview of Body of Speech
- Transition to Body



Say It

- Body, Middle
- 3-4 Points
- Clear, Concise Information on Each Point
- Transitions Between Points
- Transition to Conclusion



Say What You Said

- Conclusion, Ending
- Summarize Body of Speech
- Wrap Up
- Concluding Transition
- Thank You, Q&A
